As I reflect on the progress Leilani Farm Sanctuary has made in the five-and-a-half years since we first became a non-profit organization, I feel tremendous gratitude to our supporters. 

Humane Education makes a WOLRD OF DIFFERENCE

Leilani Farm Sanctuary hosts at-risk youth programs, school field trips, special-needs visitors, elder activities, and farm tours for the general public. Visitors to the Sanctuary often have life-changing experiences and develop a deepened sense of the value of all life—and the role that kindness plays in our relationships with all living beings. The Sanctuary's ultimate goal is to promote compassion by providing a model of humane living and animal advocacy.

Most of the animals at Leilani Farm Sanctuary were orphaned, neglected, or abused. Through interaction with these animals, children from troubled homes learn forgiveness, courage, strength, leadership skills, trust, empathy, and kindness. The animals themselves become role models, helping children learn to forgive, overcome their pasts, and reach toward a hopeful future. By learning empathy and respect for all life, children can break the cycle of violence and become protectors rather than abusers. The healing that takes place when children interact with the animals is profound.



Our humane education and therapeutic programs are administered by Programs Director, Melody Hofmann, with the assistance of psychiatrist Barry Sultanoff, M.D. Melody gained extensive experience as Programs Director for Whispering Hope Animal Ranch in Arizona, designing programs for an 80-acre summer camp for disabled and at-risk youth and received the Arizona Golden Rule Citizen Award for her work with autistic children and their families.
